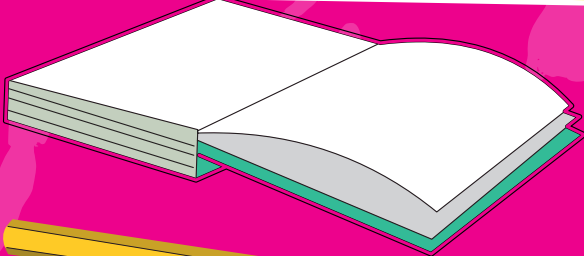

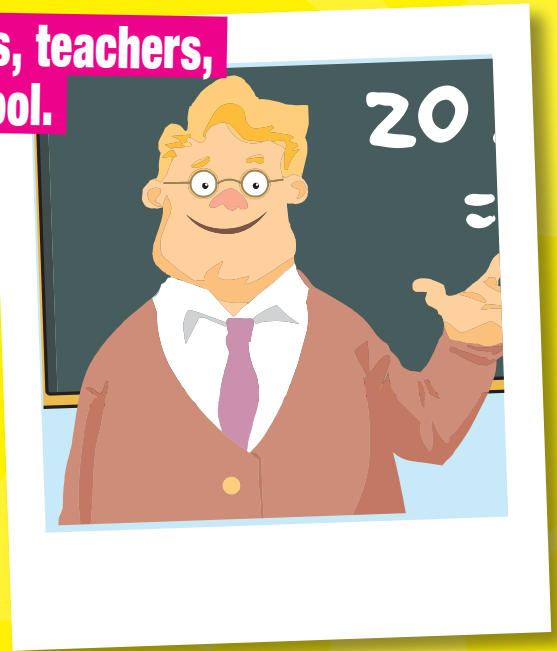
Talk to your parents about memories you will be taking with you. What can you do now that you couldn't do when you first moved here?

Keep important objects which remind you of the place you are leaving.

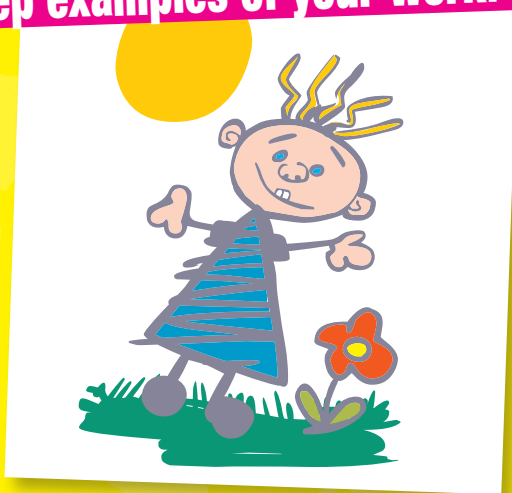


recording
